



BLOCK 39 - CITY OF SWEENEY, TEXAS

GENERAL INFORMATION: WHEN THE TOWNSITE OF SWEENEY, TEXAS WAS LAID OUT IN 1911, THE ORIGINAL BLOCKS WERE 250' X 300', AND CONTAINED 24 LOTS 25' X 100', AND 4 LOTS 25' X 150', FOR A TOTAL OF 75,000 SQUARE FEET. THE MAP SHOWS BLOCK 39, IN THE CENTER OF TOWN, ON MAIN STREET, WHERE STATE F.M. HIGHWAYS #524 AND #1459 CROSS.

LOTS #4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, AND A PORTION OF LOTS 27 AND 28, ARE OWNED BY MARHA AND J.E. ROBINSON. THEY PROPOSE TO DEED LOTS 8, 9, AND 10, INCLUDING THE "EADES BUILDING," TO BRAZORIA COUNTY AS THE SITE OF FUTURE SWEENEY HISTORICAL MUSEUM, A DIVISION OF BRAZORIA COUNTY HISTORICAL MUSEUM.

THEIR ADJACENT PROPERTY, 25,000 SQUARE FEET INCLUDING THE "CR BUILDING," IS FOR SALE AND OFFERED TO BRAZORIA COUNTY, IF INTERESTED, AS A CENTER FOR HISTORICAL, TOURISM, AND OFFICE SPACE. IT IS AIR CONDITIONED, CONTAINS 6 OFFICES AND BATHROOM, AND AN ATTACHED BARBER SHOP AND APARTMENT.
